How would you describe 'fruit'? We find other references to 'fruit' in Galatians 5:22-23: Why is it so important to pray for these? Do you think that there is a certain fruit that is more important than others?

Jesus makes a strong emphasis on love and friendship in v.13-15. Why is it important for us to know this?

What privileges does a friend have over a servant (v.15)?

What steps can you take to develop a more intimate relationship with Christ?

Finish by praying for each other. Pray that we would all 'remain in Him'. Pray that we would continue to grow in intimacy, and allow God to prune us in order that we may be more fruitful.
