Luke 18:1-43

Luke 18:1-8 This parable does not teach us to pray, as we already know our God and our desire is to pray to Him regularly. We know what is right and wrong, we know we have a home in heaven, we know the many things we need to pray for. Prayer should be special part of our daily life, just as breathing is, eating and drinking is. We don't need to be told to do this, they come naturally.

This parable teaches us how to pray. The point here is the passionate and frequency, the perseverance, the persistence in prayer. We are to daily praise our God, our very being encourages us to give thanks to our wonderful God. If we don't pray, we go to battle, having left our weapons behind us in our house; to go to our daily work without the strength gained by our morning meal; to attempt the bar where the ocean roars and rocks hide their rugged heads without taking our pilot on board.

The parable teaches persevering prayer. As one writer says; "It is hard, fainting work—praying. It is harder to pray than to preach. We do not believe what we profess, nor feel what we say, nor wish what we ask; or, if we do, we do not take the right way of getting it. And how can we expect God to answer prayer when He sees, what we ourselves might see, that we are not earnest? If we were we would be urgent, praying in the house, by the way, on our beds, at our business. It would be an important and essential part of our daily life'

By constant dripping the water wears a hole in the hardest stone. And who, as he sat on a jutting rock, amid the spray of the roaring, flashing cataract, has not marked how by her constant flow the river has polished its rugged sides, and worn out smooth gutters for its streams. So, as it is only perseverance in grace that can carry us up to heaven, it is only perseverance in prayer that can bring its blessings down."

There are several "editions" of mankind introduced in this chapter, and each one has a spiritual lesson to teach us. Being a compassionate physician, Dr. Luke wrote about widows and politicians, Pharisees and publicans, little children and adults, rich men and beggars.
