Read Colossians 3: 1 - 11.

Q.1 (v.1,2) What things should we seek, and where should our minds or affections be set? To whom is this instruction set?

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Q.2 Why are our thought processes, (the way our minds are set) so important in our proper service to God?

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Q.3 (v.3) What does Paul mean *that we have died*? Where else in Colossians have we studied about this death? Compare the passages.

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Q.4 (v.3) What does it mean to be hidden in Christ?

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Q.5 (v.4) What will be the consequence of your new life when Christ appears? What encouragement does this give you?

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Q.6 (v.5) Discuss the kinds of conduct listed in verse 5. If we have died, what should our response be to this verse? How do we put them to death?

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Q.7 (v.6) What is the consequence of the conduct listed in verse 5 if it is unresolved?

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Q.8 (v.8) Discuss the other characteristics we should put away.

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Q.9 Is anger always wrong? Is there such a thing as good anger? Why is anger a danger?

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Q.10 (v.9) What sort of improper speech should be eliminated in verse 9? Define it. How does it hurt us?

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Q.11 (v.9,10) Discuss the difference between the old self and the new self. What does this mean for us each day?

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Q.12 (v.11) Discuss the different categories of people in verse 11. In what sense should these differences not exist in Christ? What does this teach us in our relating to various people?

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
